- Principal Update / 校长更新 / Noticias de la directora / Cập nhật từ hiệu trưởng – Principal Christy Bowman-White
 - Student pickup scheduled for Wednesday, tomorrow; precautions include wearing a mask, one person per household, stand 6 feet apart.
 - THANK YOU - Shout out for an amazing end of the year with Amazon donating 253 laptops, Alliance for Education donating about \$15,000 for food for families; Family Advocate Robin Lee working endlessly coordinating food/supplies for families; PTSA Maple Cares fundraiser.
 - Budget / 预算 / Presupuesto / Ngân sách
 - Next year's enrollment – one less Kindergarten class so 4 classes; 5 first grade classes; staffing changes coming and more information to be shared in the weekly email.
 - Due to the boundary change and less enrollment, Vice Principal Mr. Skeffington is leaving Maple.
 - Maple also losing an overage teacher (a support teacher that usually works with students in small groups).

 - Huge Thank You to Yichen, our intern from November through May! He worked on countless translation tasks, created an ELL team tutorial for parents, and started Maple Handbook.
 - Needed: volunteer to finish Maple Handbook.
 - Congrats to Yichen who is graduating; he's offered to translate for PTSA as needed.
- School Supplies Update 学校用品更新 – Bao Ng
 - Collecting money now: online option (<https://www.mapleptsa.com/bulkschoolsupplies>), cash and check (available at the student pick up in the gym tomorrow/Wednesday student pickup).
 - Supply order forms sent to teachers.
 - Maple cannot be used in the summer for supplies, shipping, staging materials but Joy Raymond has an alternative space.
 - Joy can the afterschool money be allocated for school supplies? Yes.
 - 30 students still need devices per CBW; there is enough money for laptops; hotspots an issue still; \$4000 as a cushion; next step: tiffany to order 30 chrome books and get them to CBW; July 6 summer learning starts; posting hotspots via email and social media.
 - Students cannot share supplies next year so costs might be a little higher.

- Miscellaneous

 - Starts off self-paced on schoology followed by access to a learning coach.
 - Jumpstart online for incoming Kindergartners, 8/17-21; invitation to be sent out next week with survey to learn needs of families.

 - Black Lives Matter t-shirts, signs, etc – need a team to organize – tabled and will continue offline.
